

Retail Fund Closures

We regularly review the funds we offer, and we've decided to close the Prudential Invesco UK Equity Income S2 (Inc) Life Fund on 17 November 2023. Closing a fund is not an option we take lightly. We'll close funds, when our confidence in how consistent returns will be produced in the future has significantly reduced.

When we close a fund, we offer our selected replacement fund. We aim to keep the ongoing charges the same or lower, in this case the replacement fund charges are lower.

If you're considering choosing your own replacement fund, you may want to speak with your financial adviser.
